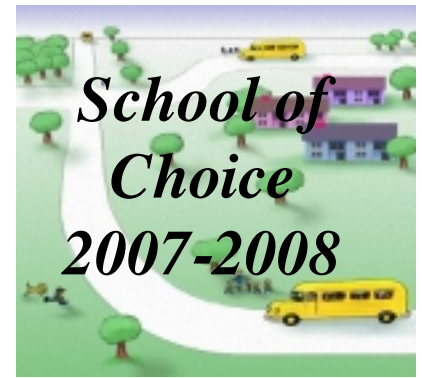


YPSILANTI PUBLIC SCHOOLS
