DATE	Test	Grades	Details
September 10 - 21, 2007	Dibels	Grades K – 3	We need Dibels training for all the elementary schools. The expectation is that Dibels data will be collected and used.
October 4 - November 30, 2007	ELPA Screening	Grades K - 11	All students who are new and identified as needing ESL services or any student who was not part of the ELPA screening.
October 8 - 26, 2007	MEAP	Grades 3 - 9	We test ELA and Math Grades 3-8. Social Studies is Grades 6 and 9. Science is Grades 5 and 8.
October 20, 2007	PSAT	Grades 10 -11	Pre SAT
October 27 – October 31, 2007	MME (ReTest)	Grade 12 ( <i>Retest-Off site with voucher</i> )	We must follow through with students and keep careful track of who has tested and who has not.
February 2008	Plan Test for Dual Enrollment	Grade 11 and 12	The Plan Test provides...
January 7 – 11, 2008	Dibels	Grades K - 3	Dibels data - second round.
January	End of Level Assessment	Grades 6-12	As the tests are developed we will give semester end of level assessments.
March 11 – 13, 2008	MME	Grade 11	Mandatory assessment. There are scholarship funds associated with passing the test.
March 25th – 27, 2008	MME (Make Ups)	Grade 11	Mandatory assessment. There are scholarship funds associated with passing the test.
March 17 – April 25, 2008	ELPA	Grades K – 12 All ESL Students	All students who are part of the ESL program will need to take the test. This test is time consuming.
April 14 – April 23, 2008	ITBS (Iowa Test of Basic Skills)	Grades 1 -8	ITBS is a Norm-Referenced test and provides another view of student data.
April 14 – April 23, 2008	GATES	Kindergarten	Given to all the Kindergarten students. The data needs to be collected and reviewed.
May 5 – May 9, 2008	Dibels	Grades K - 3	Dibels data - third round.
May 5-9 and May 12-16, 2008	Advanced Placement	AP Students	The district will pay for students in the class called A.P. to take the test.
May	End of Level Assessment	Grades 2-5	As the tests are developed we will give end of level assessments.
May	End of Level Assessment	Grades 6-12	As the tests are developed we will give semester end of level assessments.
To be determined	SAT	High School	Students can take the SAT on their own. This provides another point of reference for colleges.
To be determined	ACT	High School	Students can take the ACT on their own in order to raise their score.
To be determined	PSAT	High School	The counselors have the information on this test for the students.
No Date - Not Assessed	MLPP	Elementary	We are not collecting information on the MLPP. Teachers who want to use the assessment so they can reflect on their own students. There is no requirement for the MLPP.
No Date - Test Needed		Grades 9-10	We need some form of Norm Referenced test for the high school. We do not currently collect any information for Grades 9 and 10 but we need it.
