REQUIRED CREDITS AND COURSE DISTRIBUTION



The following requirements apply to graduating classes of 2008, 2009, and 2010. Twenty-two (22) units of credit are required to become eligible for graduation. Credits are earned in grades 9-12. One unit of credit equals one class hour for one year.

The prescribed units of credit are:

1	ENGLISH – ½ unit of credit must be earned in SPEECH or DEBATE . A maximum of one credit in DEBATE and/or FORENSICS may be applied to this requirement	4
2	SOCIAL STUDIES – ½ unit of credit must be earned in U.S. HISTORY and U.S. GOVERNMENT	2
